SPEAKER MARVEL: Do you want a machine vote?

SENATOR KILGARIN: Yes, sir.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is the advancement of the bill to E & R for Engrossment. All those in favor of the advancement of the bill vote aye, opposed vote no. Machine vote has been requested. Senator Burrows, Senator Koch, Senator Warner, Senator Schmit, Senator Rumery, Senator Goodrich, Senator Hoagland, Senator Chambers, Senator Pirsch, Senator Von Minden, Senator Carsten. The Clerk is authorized to accept call in votes.

CLERK: Senator Vard Johnson voting aye. Senator Koch voting aye. Senator Chambers voting no.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Have you all voted?

CLERK: Senator Rumery voting no. Senator Hoagland voting yes. Senator Goll voting yes. Senator Beutler voting yes.

SPEAKER MARVEL: We are looking for Senator Cullan, Senator Warner, Senator Schmit, Senator Rumery.

CLERK: Record your presence, Senator. Record your presence.
