What do you think, Senator DeCamp? You can have the rest of my time if you like.

SENATOR DeCAMP: I would...

SPEAKER MARVEL: Do you yield?

SENATOR DeCAMP: I still think that you can resolve the problem and save an awful lot of hours by meshing them but then you folks do whatever you want.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, the motion is to suspend the rules. Senator Clark.

SENATOR CLARK: Mr. President, I will withdraw my motion on there and we will go ahead and put them together and then we'll take it up in the next day or two.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Your motion is simply that you withdraw...

SENATOR CLARK: To suspend the rules, yes.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, the bill will still have to be laid over. The bill will not be debated today. So the motion before the House...all right, Senator Clark withdrew the bill and the bill is laid over. Before we go to the next piece of legislation, in the South balcony, it is my privilege to introduce fifteen students from Nebraska Wesleyan and their instructor, Professor John Vermeer, and it says here that Senator Wesely is taking credit for the students. I think Dr. Vermeer and I might object to this and indicate that we would take credit for the students.
