LB 157, 157A, 200

SENATOR CLARK: The previous question has been called for. Do I see five hands? All those in favor of ceasing debate vote aye, those opposed nay. Have you all voted? Record the vote.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays to cease debate, Mr. President.

SENATOR CLARK: Debate is ceased. Senator Marvel, what would you like to do with the bill? Debate has ceased.

SENATOR MARVEL: One other point and that is that this item is in the Governor's budget and I renew my motion to advance the bill.

SENATOR CLARK: The question before the House is the advancement of LB 157. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record the vote.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to advance 157, Mr. President.

SENATOR CLARK: The motion carried. The bill is advanced. We will take up LB 157A.

CLERK: (Read.)

SENATOR CLARK: Senator Wesely.

SENATOR WESELY: Mr. President, I move that LB 157A be advanced. It appropriates the funds to carry out LB 157.

SENATOR CLARK: Is there any discussion on the advancement of LB 157A? If not, all those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Have you all voted on the advancement of LB 157A? Voting aye, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Senator Clark voting aye.

SENATOR CLARK: Record the vote.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to advance the A bill, Mr. President.

SENATOR CLARK: The motion carried. The bill is advanced. LB 200.

CLERK: LB 200 was a bill introduced by Senator Elroy Hefner. (Read.) The bill was read on January 15, referred to the Public Works Committee. It was advanced to General File. I have no amendments on the bill, Mr. President.
