SPEAKER MARVEL: Do you want to turn your light off too please. Senator Labedz, your light is on. The motion is the Cullan amendment to LB 437. All those in favor of the adoption of that amendment vote aye, opposed vote no. We are voting on the Cullan amendment to LB 437. Record the vote.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays on the adoption of the Wesely amendment, Mr. President.
