CLERK: Mr. President, LB 134, I have no E & R amendments. The first amendment I do have, however, is from Senator Beutler. (Read Beutler amendment as found on page 1508, Legislative Journal.) That is offered by Senator Beutler.

PRESIDENT: All right, the Chair recognizes Senator Beutler.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Mr. Speaker, members of the Legislature, LB 134 I understand has a kill motion up on it. Senator Fenger needed a little more time to work on some amendments so the bill will not be debated today, basically, but I think this one small amendment can be taken care of and it is technical, completely technical in nature. It is in response to the Attorney General's opinion that was requested by Senator DeCamp. The Attorney General's opinion said the bill as a whole was constitutional, that there was no problem with it, but there was one small sentence that needed to be made more specific and that is exactly what we have done to satisfy the constitutional problem. So I would ask that you adopt this one small technical amendment and then the real debate on the bill will be next time around, I guess. Thank you, Mr. Speaker.

PRESIDENT: The Chair recognizes Senator Wesely. Any further discussion on the Beutler amendment to LB 134? Senator Beutler, do you wish to close then? No closing. The question is the adoption of the Beutler amendment to LB 134. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record the vote.

CLERK: 29 ayes, 0 nays on the adoption of Senator Beutler's amendment to the bill, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Motion carries. The Beutler amendment is adopted. Further amendments on the bill.

CLERK: Mr. President, I have an amendment from Senator Wagner. It is found on page 1467.

PRESIDENT: The Chair recognizes Senator Wagner.

SENATOR WAGNER: Mr. Speaker and members, this is the amendment that I talked about the other day on General File. It is similar to Senator Beutler's. It is technical in nature, and if you did want to follow that in the Journal it is on page 1467 and 1468. Basically what it does is just when it talks about campaign material and office supplies, this is being amended to include campaign signs and campaign sign making material. It is only technical in nature. I think that I have talked to Shirley Marsh. It kind of affects her. Senator Fitzgerald has got some sign making equipment around.
