LB 58, 283, 491

SPEAKER MARVEL: We now we proceed with Final Reading. It is item number five. Will all legislators please return to your seats. Unauthorized personnel please leave the floor. As soon as . . . all legislators must be in their seats before we can continue with item number five, Final Reading. Okay, read.

CLERK: Read LB 58

SPEAKER MARVEL: All provisions of law having been complied with, the question is, shall the bill pass? Those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. LB 58 on Final Reading. Have you all voted? Record the vote.

CLERK: 44 ayes, 1 nay, 4 excused and not voting. Vote appears on page 1531 of the Legislative Journal.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The bill is declared passed on Final Reading. Before we go to the next bill, it is my privilege to announce a group of 83 students from Central High School in Omaha and two sponsors, Mr. Clyde Lincoln and Mr. Dean Neff and they are guest of Senator Higgins and include her niece Miss Chris Andreasen. Will you raise your hands and show us where you are so we can welcome you this morning. Okay. The Clerk will now read on Final Reading LB 283.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Read LB 283.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All provisions of law having been complied with, the question is, shall the bill pass? Those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. 283 on Final Reading. Record the vote.

ASSISTANT CLERK: 46 ayes, 0 nays, 1 present and not voting, 2 excused and not voting. Vote appears on page 1532 of the Legislative Journal.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The bill is declared passed on Final Reading. LB 283. We now take the last Final Reading of the morning, LB 491. Clerk will read.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Read Lb 491.
