SENATOR NICHOL: Record. Hease.

CLERK: 34 ayes, 9 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to readvance the bill.

SENATOR NICHOL: The bill is advanced. Senator Labedz has 36 students in the north balcony who are students of CETA and are studying English as a secondary language, and 4 teachers.
