LB 216, 303

SENATOR CLARK: The motion carried. The committee amendments are adopted. On the bill itself, Senator Koch, do you move for the advancement?

SENATOR KOCH: I move for the advancement of LB 303, as amended, to E & R Initial.

SENATOR CLARK: Is there any discussion on the advancement of 303 to Initial? If not, all those in favor vote aye, all those opposed vote nay. Voting aye.

CLERK: Senator Clark voting aye.

SENATOR CLARK: Have you all voted? Record the vote.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to advance the bill.

SENATOR CLARK: The motion carried. The bill is advanced. The next bill is 216.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 216 introduced by the Ag and Environment Committee and signed by its members. (Read title.) The bill was read on January 15, referred to Ag and Environment for hearing. The bill was advanced to General File with the committee amendments attached, Mr. President.

SENATOR CLARK: Senator Schmit on the committee amendments.

SENATOR SCHMIT: Mr. President and members of the Legislature, basically all the committee amendments do is to exempt radioactive waste from the provisions of the bill and the reason for that is that those wastes are already regulated by the Department of Health. And I move the adoption of the committee amendments.

SENATOR CLARK: Is there any discussion on the committee amendments? If not, all those in favor vote aye. All those opposed vote nay.

CLERK: Senator Clark voting aye.

SENATOR CLARK: Record the vote.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of the committee amendments.
