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came back to the Appropriations Committee and said that that level of funding would not be sufficient to finish the track. Rather than starting it half way like some agencies might, they decided to come back to the Appropriations Committee and request full funding. They did that and it is my understanding now that the \$95,000 which the Legislature did grant to the State Colleges is now being, for the purpose of the track at Chadron, it is now being snatched away from them, is that accurate?

SENATOR WARNER: Well it is not quite....well it is really accurate from your point of view Senator Cullan. As I understand, it is true we did appropriate money a couple of years ago and made the adjustment and my understanding is now that they want to relocate the track. It seems to me that it was another hundred thousand or so thereabouts that they wanted in total and it would be accurate then to state that the committee did not recommend another hundred thousand to relocate the track and my presumption is that it was inappropriate to fix it where it is so, we abolished the funding in its entirety then.

SENATOR CULLAN: Thank you Senator Warner, I appreciate that. Mr. President, members of the Legislature, I of course feel a little that it is unfortunate we did appropriate the \$95,000 one time for this facility, for an all weather track on the campus at Chadron State College, I understand the Appropriations Committee's concern about spending more funds than that for that track I simply wanted to bring it to the attention of the Legislature that in fact we had spend \$95,000 a couple of years ago for athletic facilities at Chadron State College. I think that it is commendable that the Board of Regents saw that they could not, excuse me, the Board of Trustees saw that they could not accomplish the goal for the funds appropriated and rather than spending those funds they decided to wait and seek further guidance from the Appropriations Committee, so I would just bring that up to your attention at this point and time. Hopefully you will consider that when Senator Haberman has a motion up to appropriate \$146,000 for the activity center later. I think that it is pertinent because it is clear that we already have at one time appropriated \$95,000 for athletic facilities at Chadron and I think that it is good that the Board of Trustees didn't go ahead and spend part of that money and do the job half way. I just wanted to call attention to the fact that that money was once there, it is now gone. Thank you.

SENATOR CLARK: Senator Haberman. Senator Haberman. The
