CLERK: Senator Clark voting yes.

SENATOR CLARK: Record the vote.

CLERK: (Read record vote as found on pages 1922-1923 of the Legislative Journal.) 39 ayes, 6 nays, 3 excused and not voting, 1 present and not voting, Mr. President.

SENATOR CLARK: The bill is declared passed. The Clerk will now read 459A.

CLERK: Mr. President, I have a motion on the desk.

SENATOR CLARK: Read the motion.

CLERK: Senator Fowler moves to return LB 459A to Select File for a specific amendment. The amendment is on page 1118 of the Journal.

SENATOR CLARK: Senator Fowler.

SENATOR FOWLER: Mr. President, this is a technical amendment to distribute the retirement fund, the additional contribution to the retirement fund among the appropriate state agencies. The way that the state employees match, the employer match for the state employees contribution for the retirement fund works is that each agency has it in its own budget and, therefore, we had to do a computer run on payroll to establish the dollar amount necessary to fund the sections within 459A and that is all this amendment does, is distribute that money among the appropriate agencies for their contribution. With that, I would move to return it to Select File.

SENATOR CLARK: The question is the return of 459A to Select File. All those in favor vote aye. All those opposed vote nay.

CLERK: Senator Clark voting yes.

SENATOR CLARK: Record the vote.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to return the bill, Mr. President.

SENATOR CLARK: The bill is returned. Senator Fowler.

SENATOR FOWLER: I move the amendment be adopted.
