ASSISTANT CLERK: (Record vote read. See page 2040, Legislative Journal.) The vote is 37 ayes, 7 nays, 3 excused and not voting, 2 present and not voting, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The bill is declared passed on Final Reading. The Clerk will now read LB 310 on Final Reading.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read LB 310 on Final Reading.)

SPEAKER MARVEL: All provisions of law having been complied with, the question is, shall the bill pass? Those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. LB 310 on Final Reading. Record the vote.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read record vote. See page 2041, Legislative Journal.) The vote is 44 ayes, 0 nays, 3 excused and not voting, 2 present and not voting, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The bill is declared passed on Final Reading. The Clerk will now read on Final Reading LB 316E.

CLERK: Mr. President, I have a motion on the desk. Mr. President, Senator Koch would move to return LB 316 to Select File for specific amendment. The amendment would read as follows: (Read. See Page 2041, Legislative Journal.)

SPEAKER MARVEL: The Chair recognizes Senator Koch.

SENATOR KOCH: Thank you, Mr. Speaker. In checking this bill on Final Reading, we find that there was a technical error that was made in our E & R drafting. In order to make the bill consistent, we have to strike that #4 and insert the #3 because it is used on three other occasions throughout the body of the bill and so we are merely harmonizing it before we send it back for Final Reading and I ask for the adoption of the amendment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is to return the bill to Select File for a specific amendment. Senator Nichol, do you wish the floor?

SENATOR NICHOL: Just a question of Senator Koch. On line 12, it says "four" also and I just looking at it for a moment, should that be changed or not?
