a maiority of those present to overrule the Chair. I thought it was a majority.

SENATOR CLARK: A majority of those present.
SENATOR WESELY: Would overrule?
SENATOR CLARK: ?es.
SENATOR WESELY: I guess we will go to a roll call. That will be fine.

SENATOR CLARK: A majority of those present and voting. Call the roil. Shall the Chair be overruled.

CLERK: 15 ayes, 18 nays, 1 present and not voting, 14 excused and not voting, $l$ absent and not voting. Vote appears on page 2295 of the Legislative Journal.

SENATOR CLARK: The Chair is sustained.
CLERK: Mr. President, I have nothing further on the bill.
SENATOR CLARK: The ouestion before the House is the advancement of 544. All those in favor say aye, opposed. The bill is advanced. LB 344.

CLERK: Mr. President, with respect to LB 344 , there are $E \& R$ amendments pending.

SENATOR CLARK: Senator Kilgarin.
SENATOR KILGARIN: I move the $E \& R$ amendments to $L B 344$.
SENATOR CLARK: You heard the motion. All those in favor say aye, opposed no. The E \& R amendments are adopted. Anything further on the bill?

CLERK: Mr. President, I have an amendment from Senators Landis and Koch.

SENATOR CLARK: Senator Landis.
SENATOR LANDIS: Mr. Speaker, I would move the advancement of LB 344 which is the non-resident violators compact. Oh, excuse me. I move the adoption of the amendment.
