SENATOR DeCAMP: I move we advance.

PRESIDENT: The motion is to adopt the DeCamp amendment to LB 234A. Any discussion? Hearing none, the question then is, shall the DeCamp amendment be adopted. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record the vote.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 1 nay, Mr. President.

The next bill is LB 523, Mr. Clerk. Pass over that, nothing on it. Oh, all right, the Chair recognizes Senator Newell.

SENATOR NEWELL: Mr. President, yesterday I pulled that amendment off and it is still on the sheet. After the Public Service Commission thing didn't go I felt there was no need to be doing those kinds of amendments so I did withdraw it from consideration of this body.
