CLERK: 31 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of the Wesely-Beutler amendment.

PRESIDENT: The motion carries. The amendment is adopted. Any further amendments? Okay, now the question before the House is the adoption of the Lamb amendment as amended. Senator Lamb, do you wish to say anything further? No others wishing to speak to it, the question then is the adoption of the Lamb amendment as amended. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Record the vote.

CLERK: 32 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of Senator Lamb's amendment.

PRESIDENT: All right, the Lamb amendment is adopted. Now, anything further?

CLERK: Mr. President, the motion now is to adopt the permanent rules as amended.

PRESIDENT: All right, motion to adopt the permanent rules as amended. Senator Wesely, do you have any final close on the rules? The question then is the adoption of the rules as amended, adoption of all the rules as amended. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record the vote.
