SENATOR CLARK: The bill is withdrawn. Revenue Committee report on gubernatorial appointments.

CLERK: Mr. President, there is a Revenue Committee report regarding a confirmation hearing on Mr. Donald Leuenberger and that is offered by Senator Carsten as chair of the Revenue Committee.

SENATOR CLARK: Senator Carsten.

SENATOR CARSTEN: Mr. President and members of the Legislature, on Monday of this week our committee held an interview with Mr. Leuenberger, the appointee to the Director of Revenue. We had a very interesting and questioning interview with him and the committee in their final analysis were certainly aware of the ability of Mr. Leuenberger to serve in that capacity and unanimously voted to recommend him, recommend his appointment for confirmation to the Legislature. And with that, I urge you to support this confirmation.

SENATOR CLARK: The question before the House is the confirmation of Mr. Leuenberger for Director of Revenue. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay.

CLERK: Senator Clark voting yes.

SENATOR CLARK: Record the vote.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on approval of the report.

SENATOR CLARK: Mr. Leuenberger is approved. The Education Committee report, gubernatorial report appointment.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Koch offers a report regarding a confirmation hearing of Mr. Gene Moody and Mr. Henry Krugg. The report is found on page 243 of the Journal.

SENATOR CLARK: Senator Koch.

SENATOR KOCH: Mr. President, members of the body, the Education Committee held interviews with Mr. Moody and Mr. Krugg last week. They are appointments suggested by the Governor to the Educational Lands and Funds, trustees, and the committee reports them favorably for your confirmation.

SENATOR CLARK: You have heard the report. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Have you all voted? Record the vote.
