repealed the mandatory retirement for public employees and the United States Government has repealed the mandatory retirement age for federal workers. As the baby boom population ages and the number of workers supporting retirees decreases, it is time to evaluate the labor market and state retirement policy. The intent of 287 is to remove artificial and arbitrary barriers to the continued employment of efficient and capable older workers. And I might say that these workers continue to be taxpayers instead of tax users. Mr. President, I move the advancement of the LB 287.
