LB 604, 604A

SENATOR V. JOHNSON: I understand that, Mr. Speaker, and so I am going to make this very quick. Senator Cope, I just would like to ask one question. I want you to know I wholeheartedly support your bill. The bill does have a fiscal note of \$6 million. I assume that is money that we traditionally appropriate to this function in any event. Is that correct?

SENATOR COPE: That will be answered in the A bill and Senator Warner will take care of that.

SENATOR V. JOHNSON: All right. That will be it then. Thank you.

SENATOR CLARK: The question before the House is the advancement of the bill. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay.

CLERK: Senator Clark voting yes.

SENATOR CLARK: Record the vote.

CLERK: 32 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to advance 604.

SENATOR CLARK: The bill is advanced. Senator Warner, will 604 take long for you?

SENATOR WARNER: The A bill?

SENATOR CLARK: Yes.

SENATOR WARNER: I move the bill be....

CLERK: There is a committee amendment.

SENATOR WARNER: I move adoption of the committee amendment.

SENATOR CLARK: We are on the committee amendment to LB 604A.

SENATOR WARNER: The A bill provides the funding for the continuation of the agency as Senator Cope has indicated, otherwise would have discontinued July 1 of '82, and the funding for that administrative cost is necessary to carry with it. The committee amendment strikes the portion of the \$6 million for maintenance repair for this coming year. That is a matter that will be handled in
