SENATOR DeCAMP: Mr. President, I move you approve it.

PRESIDENT: Motion is made to approve the gubernatorial appointments by the Banking Committee Chairman. Any discussion? If not, all those in favor of approving the gubernatorial appointments, Banking Committee, found in this report vote aye, opposed nay. Record the vote.

CLERK: 35 ayes, 0 mays on approval of the report, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Motion carries and the report of the Banking Committee is approved. The Chair recognizes Speaker Marvel.

SPEAKER MARVEL: In a few moments the Clerk's Office will pass out the latest consent calendar information. In an attempt to try to reduce the workload, we will start consent calendar on Friday of this week so what you should do to start with now is to be sure you have a copy of the consent calendar dated March 5th, 1982.

PRESIDENT: All right. Any questions? Thank you, Speaker Marvel. The next report then, Mr. Clerk, is on the Judiciary Committee's gubernatorial appointments.

CLERK: Mr. President, the Judiciary Committee reports favorably upon the appointments of Doris Collins, Board Of Parole, and Colonel Kohmetscher, Superintendent of the Nebraska State Patrol. The report is found on page 827 of the Journal.

PRESIDENT: The Chair recognizes Senator Nichol.

SENATOR NICHOL: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, the Judiciary Committee did hold hearings on these two people and they voted unanimously, those that were present, to recommend Colonel Elmer Kohmetscher, Superintendent of the State Patrol, and Doris Collins, member of the Board of Parole.

PRESIDENT: Is there any discussion on the Judiciary Committee's report on gubernatorial appointments? If not, all those in favor of approving the Judiciary Committee's report vote aye, opposed nay. Record the vote.

CLERK: 33 ayes, 0 mays on adoption of the Judiciary Committee report, Mr. President.
