SENATOR CLARK: You have heard the motion. All those in favor say aye. Opposed. The E & R amendments are adopted. Anything further on the bill?

ASSISTANT CLERK: Nothing further, Mr. President.

SENATOR CLARK: Senator Kilgarin.

SENATOR KILGARIN: I move we advance LB 829.

SENATOR CLARK: The motion is to advance LB 829. All those in favor say aye. Opposed. The bill is advanced. LB 606.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Mr. President, I have no E & R amendments and I have nothing on the bill.

SENATOR CLARK: Senator Kilgarin.

SENATOR KILGARIN: I move we advance LB 606.

SENATOR CLARK: You heard the motion. All those in favor say aye. Opposed. The bill is advanced. LB 579.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Mr. President, I have no E & R amendments. I do have an amendment from Senator Koch. That amendment is to add the emergency clause.

SENATOR CLARK: Senator Koch. The motion before the House is to add the emergency clause. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Senator Clark voting yes.

SENATOR CLARK: Have you all voted on the emergency clause? Record the vote.

ASSISTANT CLERK: 29 ayes, 0 nays on the adoption of the Koch amendment, Mr. President.

SENATOR CLARK: The amendment is adopted. Senator Kilgarin on the advancement of the bill.

SENATOR KILGARIN: I move we advance LB 579.

SENATOR CLARK: You have heard the motion. All those in favor say aye. Opposed. The bill is advanced. LB 703.
