SENATOR LABEDZ: Thank you, Mr. President. C. Mickey Skinner was appointed by the Governor to replace Bob Cunningham as a Games and Parks Commissioner. He is from the Second District and he is appointed for a five year term. He received a unanimous vote of approval from the committee and Mr. Skinner has a long line of civic activities and business association and activities from the City of Omaha, also the Executive Vice-President of the Skinner Macaroni Company and I ask the members of the body to approve Mr. Skinner as the replacement for Bob Cunningham as the Games and Parks Commissioner.

PRESIDENT: All right, any discussion on the report of the Constitutional Revision Committee. The question then before the House is the adoption of the committee report thereby approving the gubernatorial appointment. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record the vote.

CLERK: 37 ayes, 0 nays on the adoption of the report, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Senator Barrett, are you ready to report on your Business and Labor gubernatorial appointment? Senator Barrett.

SENATOR BARRETT: Mr. President and members, the Business and Labor Committee desires to report favorably on the reappointment of Mr. Dean Kratz as Judge to the Commission of Industrial Relations. The committee approved the reappointment of Mr. Kratz and would suggest a record vote. Thank you.

PRESIDENT: Any further discussion on the Business and Labor Committee's report on the gubernatorial appointment of Mr. Kratz. If not, the question before the House is the adoption of that report. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record the vote.

CLERK: 37 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on approval of the report.
