PRESIDENT: Any objections? If not, so ordered.

CLERK: That is all that I have, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Before we take up some important announcement by Senator Lamb, I'd like to introduce from Senator Apking's district on her behalf, we have some 14 seniors from Hebron High School, Computer Science Class, Mr. Jim Fraser their teacher. They are up here I guess in the North balcony. Yes, back there. Would they wave to us so we know where they are. Welcome to your Legislature, Hebron. We also have in the North balcony some 20 students from the Nebraska State Student Association including Chris Walsh, the chairperson of the board of directors, Rick Mockler, treasurer and board member and Nette Nelson, secretary of the board, Deb Chappell, chairperson of legislative assembly. Kim Kureger the vice chair person of legislative assembly. They are from the University of Nebraska, Lincoln, the University of Nebraska, Omaha, Wayne State College and Kearney State College. So would you welcome the Nebraska State Student Association representatives. Welcome to your Legislature. The Chair recognizes Senator Lamb for a very important announcement. Senator Lamb.

SENATOR LAMB: Mr. President, members of the Legislature. I'm sorry to have to bring bad news this morning that Senator Marvel is in the hospital and plans to be there all week. He is not receiving visitors. He is suffering from exhaustion and will not be with us this week. He is not, of course, in any danger. He is in good spirits but he will be in the hospital all week. I would draw your attention to the agenda for today and LB 458 will be laid over. Senator Fowler is not here as well as LB 854 and 854A. Also LB 909 will be laid over. Senator Goll is not here. LB 938 on today's agenda is an error, does not qualify for the General File priority consent calendar so that will be stricken. Otherwise the agenda will be as you have it before you. Special order at 1:30 p.m., LB 202 by Senator Chambers will come at that time, whether or not we finish item 5 this morning. Thank you.

PRESIDENT: Any questions of Senator Lamb? Yes.

SENATOR GOODRICH: Howard, would you repeat the last two you referred to? The first two I kept up with but I couldn't find the last two in time to mark them.

SENATOR LAMB: Okay, LB 458 will be laid over, LB 854 and 854A. Senator Landis has just informed me that Senator Goll has asked him to take LB 909 so it will be taken up rather than laid over. And LB 938 is an error and that will be stricken from the list.
