CLERK: Mr. President, LB 759 was a bill introduced by Senator farvel at the request of the Governor and Senator farner. (Read title). The bill was read on Tanuary llth of this year and referred to the Eublic Works Committee. The bill was advanced to General File, :lr. President.

SENATOR LAMA: Senator Warner on the bill.
SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, the bill was introduced for the Governor and I had my name added, as you know, Senator "arvel is not here. Eut it was to defer the issuance of new license plates for one year. I notice on the desk that there are some other amendments. I have no idea what the Governor's position is on those since it is his bill, but $I$ would move that the bill be advanced and $t: 1$ the absence of Senator Marvel I ruess I don't know if I want to take a position on the amendrients at this time, I wouldn't know if they are appropriate or not, but at least I think the bill ought to be advanced today because it is important that it be advanced in the event that the new issuance of plates is not going to occur and I don't think it should be held up. I move its advancement.

SENATOR LAMB: Mr. Clerk.
CLERK: Mr. President, the first amendment $I$ have to the bill is offered by Senator Clark and that amendment is on page 840 of the Legislative Journal.
SENATOR LAMB: Senator Clark.
SENATOR CLARK: Mr. President, members, what this amendment would do would be to put one license plate on the rear of the automobile and in the year that the rew issue would come out there would be one dollar additional charge so that the people will ray for the license plate. Let me explain to you what has been happenin:". Rif:ht now we have plates such as Senator Vickers has displayed back there which is a common plate oit in my country, that you can't even read any more. People are hiphly disturbed by the fact that they are paying $\$ 16.50$ and Eettine a little tas and that is all that they are petting. They are not rettin a new clate, they are not eettini a change of color. As nearly as I can fiecure out by the figures I have received 15 or $20 \%$ of the people out in the state are not resistering their automobiles at ail. Ne are losin: the entire $\$ 16.50$ and you and I are pickile up that difference. I would like to see the ifcense plates chaned. I don't care if they are in cardboard. I would Just like to see them out there chanzed to a new col so that we could pick up those $15-20 \%$ of the peorle that are not resisterin" their plates at the present time.
