the University of Nebraska. Normally we never do that for the simple reason that both of those agencies always utilize virtually their total general fund appropriation within the fiscal year that it is appropriated. However, both of the agencies to assist with the cash flow problems that the state is incurring is using some of their cash funds and leaving some of the general fund money longer in the state general fund to assist with that problem. But to ensure that in the event the money was not totally paid back...not paid back, to ensure that if they leave some funds come June 30th still in the general fund if it is necessary and they are willing and can do it, we need to reappropriate that unexpended balance so that it can be done at no loss. So I would move the adoption of all....

SENATOR CLARK: You have one minute.

SENATOR WARNER: I would move adoption of all three amendments.

SENATOR CLARK: The question before the House is the adoption of all three amendments. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. We are taking all three amendments at the same time.

CLERK: Senator Clark voting yes.

SENATOR CLARK: Record the vote.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of the Appropriations Committee amendments.

SENATOR CLARK: They are all adopted. The next amendment.

SENATOR KOCH: Thank you, Mr. Chairman, and members of the body, the amendment I am offering is an amendment that treats the technical community colleges in the State of Nebraska. I handed out to you just a moment ago an explanation of this amendment. I will just briefly comment on what the amendment proposes to do. My amendment would increase the aid to community colleges to \$19,590,562, and this would be based on the 3.75 percent increase in aid the same as the Appropriations Committee recommends.
