SENATOR LAMB: Next bill is LB 568.

CLERK: Mr. President, I have E & R amendments to LB 568.

SENATOR LAMB: Sentor Kilgarin.

SENATOR KILGARIN: . . E & R amendments to LB 568.

SENATOR LAMB: The motion is to advance. . . to adopt E & R amendments. Those in favor say aye, those opposed no. E & R amendments are adopted.

CLERK: Mr. President, the next amendment I have is by Senator DeCamp. I understand he wishes to withdraw. Senator, this is Request #2773.

SENATOR LAMB: Senator DeCamp.

SENATOR Decamp: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, I said that I would offer my amendments. I got letters from just about everybody involved in alcoholism. I have the President of the MAD Mothers, Mothers Against Drunk Drivers, supporting it, the Patrol, Council on Alcoholism so on and so forth. However to spend a hour debating this when the new amendments that Senator Haberman and Nichol and some others have come up with, come about 75% of the way to what I am trying there, I think I would just rather go along and save the time and go with what you have got, maybe you will decide to adopt this additional procedure next year. The idea of this to have it more swift and certain and efficient but as I say your penalities are identical basically to what I have got, so I'll withdraw those and hope that we get yours adopted.

SENATOR LAMB: The amendment is withdrawn. Next amendment please.

CLERK: Mr. President, the next amendment I have is from Senators Haberman, Nichol and Hoagland. It is on page 1354 of the Legislative Journal.

SENATOR LAMB: Senator Nichol.

SENATOR NICHOL: Pat, is that the short one or the long one?

CLERK: It is a page long, Senator.
