SENATOR BEUTLER: I would like to ask for a Call of the House and a roll call vote.

SENATOR CLARK: All right, a Call of the House has been requested. All those in favor of a Call vote aye, opposed vote nay. Record the vote.

CLERK: 10 nays, 1 nay to go under Call, Mr. President.

SENATOR CLARK: The House is under Call. All Senators will return to their seats please and check in. We are under Call. Sergeant of Arms, will you get them back in their seats please? We have six excused. We are looking for Senator Koch, Senator Newell, Senator Hoagland, Senator Haberman, and Senator Kahle. Senator Beutler, did you want a roll call vote? All right, the Clerk will call the roll and what we are voting on...pardon? What we are voting on is to return the bill for specific amendment by Senator Beutler. The Clerk will call the roll.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken. See page 1722, Legislative Journal.) 16 ayes, 26 nays, Mr. President.

SENATOR CLARK: Motion lost. The Call is raised. Next motion.

CLERK: Mr. President, if I may, right before that, Senator Lamb would like to remind the Executive Board that they have a meeting tomorrow at twelve o'clock, that is Executive Board at twelve o'clock tomorrow in Room 2102.

Mr. President, study resolution, LR 360 offered by Senators Landis, Wiitala and Beyer calls for a study of services of the Sanitary and Improvement Districts and what they are permitted to offer their residents. LR 361 by Senator DeCamp concerns prisoners of the Nebraska State Penal Complex as it relates to prison industries. Those will both be referred to the Board, Mr. President. Mr. President, the next amendment I have is offered by Senator Koch. Senator Koch would move to return the bill for a specific amendment.

SENATOR CLARK: Senator Koch.

SENATOR KOCH: Thank you, Mr. Chairman. Members of the body, the amendment I propose is to reinsert \$10,000 in the Library Commission. This \$10,000 comes from the services the Library Commission furnishes to the blind and visually
