ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read LB 909 on Final Reading.)

SENATOR CLARK: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall the bill pass with the emergency clause attached. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Voting aye.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Senator Clark voting yes.

SENATOR CLARK: Have you all voted? Record the vote.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Record vote read. See page 1916, Legislative Journal.) The vote is 45 ayes, 1 nay, 3 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

SENATOR CLARK: The bill is declared passed with the emergency clause attached. We will now take up LB 568.
