SENATOR CLARK: They are approved. The second from the Public Health and Welfare.

CLERK: Mr. President, the report is found on page 1452 of the Journal.

SENATOR CLARK: Senator Cullan.

SENATOR CULLAN: Mr. President, members of the Legislature...

SENATOR CLARK: Could we have it a little quiet so we could hear please.

SENATOR CULLAN: . . . another committee on committee report. This is the . . . the Public Health and Welfare Committee met and the confirmation hearings for the Manufactured Housing Advisory Board, we considered Mr. Innes, Mr. Lynch, Mr. Rogers, Mr. Rhode, Mr. Tompkins and Mr. Huff. There was another individual whose name I do not recall at this point and time who did not come and did not send a resume and did not respond in any form so the committee didn't respond either.
