PRESIDENT: All right, do you want to interpose that question to the Speaker since he is the only one who can discuss this motion at all? Speaker Marvel.

SENATOR NICHOL: Mr. Speaker, would that be all right.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Mr. Clerk, can you read the items that we have made up that addresses the problem as to how long we need to remain here? Can you read that? You have that?

CLERK: Yes, sir, I would be happy to.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Do you have the sheet up there that you made for me and we discussed it jointly?

CLERK: All right, Mr. President, this is a proposed calendar submitted to the Speaker for his consideration and would be as follows: On Tuesday, November 3, which, of course, is today would be devoted essentially to housekeeping and the Legislature would meet formally for just a few minutes. On Wednesday, November 4 beginning at 9:00 a.m. tomorrow morning the Legislature would begin General File debate on LB 8, the Governor's appropriation bill and it is possible that you would remain in session until that bill is advanced to E & R Initial. Thursday, November 5, the Legislature will begin Select File debate on LB 8 and again remain in session until that bill is advanced and wait for it to be reported correctly engrossed so we can meet the constitutional layover requirement. Friday, November 6th, it is possible that you would meet to use up another legislative day, again just housekeeping sorts of measures, and then Final Reading would occur on either Saturday, November 7 or Monday, November 9, depending on whatever the pleasure of the Legislature is, and adjournment would follow that.
