Approved by the Governor January 31, 1984 Introduced by Goodrich, 20

AN ACT relating to schools; to provide the governing board of a school district with certain contract powers; and to declare an emergency.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. The governing board of any school district may enter into contracts under such terms and conditions as the board deems appropriate for a period not to exceed four years for the provision of utility services, refuse disposal, transportation services, maintenance services, financial services, insurance, security services, and instructional materials, supplies, and equipment and for collective bargaining agreements with employee groups. Nothing in this section shall be construed to permit multiyear contracts with individual school district employees.

Sec. 2. Since an emergency exists, this act shall be in full force and take effect, from and after its passage and approval, according to law.
