AN ACT relating to the Nebraska Commission on Law Enforcement and Criminal Justice; to amend settion 81-1403, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943; to provide a duty; and to repeal the original section.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. That section 81-1403, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, be amended to read as follows: 81-1403. The commission, after consultation with the Nebraska Police Standards Advisory Council shall:

 Adopt rules and regulations for the operation of the training center;

(2) Appoint and remove the director of the training center and delegate appropriate powers and duties to him or her;

(3) Establish curricula and requirements for satisfactory completion of preemployment and advanced training programs;

(4) Issue certificates attesting satisfactory completion of preemployment and advanced training programs;

(5) Revoke such certificates when a law enforcement officer is convicted of a felony;

(6) (5) Set the tuition and fees of the training center:

(7) (6) Annually certify all schools any school, public or private, providing a basic course of law enforcement training which complies with the qualifications and standards promulgated by the director him and offers training comparable to that offered by the training center;

(8) (7) Extend the programs of the training center throughout the state on a regional basis; and

(9) (8) Do all things necessary to carry out the purpose of the training center.

Sec. 2. That original section 81-1403, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, is repealed.
