

## LEGISLATIVE BILL 340

AN ACT relating to employment security; to amend section 48-663, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943; to change a statute of limitations; and to repeal the original section.  
Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. That section 48-663, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, be amended to read as follows:  
48-663. Whoever makes a false statement or representation knowing it to be false or knowingly fails to disclose a material fact, to obtain or increase any benefit or other payment under sections 48-623 to 48-626, or under an employment security law of any other state, or of the federal government, or of a foreign government, either for himself or herself or for any other person, shall be guilty of a Class III misdemeanor. Each such false statement or representation or failure to disclose a material fact shall constitute a separate offense. Prosecution under this section may be instituted within three ~~two~~ years from the time the offense was committed.

Sec. 2. That original section 48-663, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, is repealed.
