PRESIDENT: All members are present. Thank you. The Chair recognizes Senator Nichol for a motion.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Mr. President, I move the rules as now in our possession be adopted for today only, Wednesday, January 9, 1985.

I have on file and it will be on file in my office both the letter of appointment from Governor Kerrey as well as the Oath of Office attested to by Secretary of State Beermann. Mr. President, and I also have on file in my office a resignation letter from former Senator Gordon McDonald. Governor Kerrey has since replaced Mr. McDonald with Jerry Chizek. And I have on file both the Oath of Office attested to by the Governor and the Secretary of State. All of those documents will be on file in my office, Mr. President.
