PRESIDENT: Very well. Mr. Clerk, all of those documents will be inserted in the Legislative Journal. The Chair recognizes next Senator Jerome Warner.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, I move that we proceed to the election of five persons to serve on the Committee of Credentials who will forthwith report to the Legislature on the credentials of those claiming to be elected to the Legislature in the general election in November of 1984.

PRESIDENT: Senator Wesely, you have your light on, do you wish recognition? Okay.

SENATOR WESELY: Yes.

PRESIDENT: Is there any discussion on the motion? All those in favor say aye. Opposed nay. Motion carried. Senator Wesely.

SENATOR WESELY: Yes. Mr. President, I move that the five senior members of the Legislature be selected to serve on the Credentials Committee. That is tradition in this body.

PRESIDENT: Senator Wesely, now you and I must figure out who are the five senior members of the Legislature. Senator Warner.

SENATOR WESELY: There's one.

PRESIDENT: Now, Senator Warner, we will appoint you Chairman. Who else will volunteer to be a senior member? Senator Chambers, you are a senior member. Senator Carsten, Senator Schmit, Senator DeCamp. You are a senior member of the Legislature in point of service and you are on the Credentials Committee. Those are the nominations that we will put in under Senator Wesely's motion. Are there any other nominations? If not, all those in favor of nominating these persons to the Credentials Committee say aye. Opposed nay. Motion carried. These members are appointed. And this committee headed by Senator Warner will retire to the back of the Chamber, please. (Gavel.) The Chair recognizes Senator Jerome Warner.
