SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President and members of the Legislature, I would like to place in nomination Senator Shirley Marsh for Vice Chairperson of the Exec Board. I had the opportunity to serve with her at least eight years now on the same committee as well as four additional years. As a member of the body I have found her at all times to be conscientious, to be extremely willing to do whatever amount of work is required throughout the functions to which she has been selected and I am sure she would continue that in this role as Vice Chairman. I would commend her to you for selection to this office.

PRESIDENT: The name of Senator Shirley Marsh is placed in nomination. Are there other nominations? Are there other nominations for Vice Chairperson of the Executive Board? Senator Warner.

PRESIDENT: Mr. President, if there are no further nominations, I would move that a unanimous ballot be cast for Senator Marsh.

PRESIDENT: The motion has been made to cast a unanimous ballot by Senator Warner, thereby ceasing other nominations and casting a unanimous ballot for Senator Marsh. All those in favor say aye. Opposed no. The motion carried. Senator Marsh, you are the Vice Chairperson of the Executive Board and the Chair recognizes you.

SENATOR MARSH: Thank you to all my colleagues.

PRESIDENT: Thank you, Senator Marsh. We will now proceed to caucus for the membership of the Executive Board. You will select two members from your caucus from each of the three congressional districts. Very well, and the Chair...to formalize this the Chair recognizes Senator Lundy.
