CLERK: Mr. President, from the 1st District Senators Wesely, Morehead and Hartnett have been nominated; from the 2nd District Senators Chizek, Lynch and Higgins; from the 3rd District Senators Sieck, Lowell Johnson and DeCamp; and from the 4th District Senators Scofield, Vickers and Pappas.

PRESIDENT: Very well, those are duly elected and the record will be the Journal. Do we have to approve that? Senator DeCamp, I believe you have a motion for us.

SENATOR DECAMP: (Response not audible.)

PRESIDENT: Senator DeCamp moves that we approve the nominations just listed by the Clerk. All those in favor say aye. Opposed no. Motion carried, those members are elected to the Committee on Committees from the old four districts. We will now proceed to another motion. We will proceed. Senator Beutler, do you have a motion for us at this time?

SENATOR BEUTLER: Mr. Speaker, I would move that Dick Hargesheimer be elected as Director of Research of the Legislative Council as outlined in Section 50-111 of the statutes.

PRESIDENT: You have heard the motion, are there...you have heard the motion of the nomination of Dick Hargesheimer to the Director of Research. Now this will be a machine vote on the board. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Members, have you all recorded your vote? Have you all recorded your vote? We will wait for Senator Johnson. The Clerk will record the vote.

CLERK: 46 ayes, 0 nays on election of Mr. Hargesheimer, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The motion carries and Mr. Hargesheimer is elected as Director of Research. The Chair recognizes Senator Lamb.

SENATOR LAMB: Mr. President, I move to proceed to the election of the committee chairpersons by secret ballot in accordance with Rule 3, Section 2c.

PRESIDENT: You have heard the motion. All those in favor
