And that is why I am running for Chairman of the Administrative Rules and Regulations Committee and you can expect me to be, as I am sure my opponent, Senator Hannibal, would be, fair to both sides. Thank you very much, Senators.

PRESIDENT: Are there other nominations? The name of Senator Marge Higgins is placed in nomination. Are there other nominations for this post? Hearing none, the Chair declares that nominations have ceased and we will proceed to vote by secret ballot for Chairman of Administrative Rules and Regulations. The Clerk and the Assistant Clerk will collect your ballots. You are voting either for Senator Hannibal or Senator Higgins. The Teller Committee...oh, I forgot to appoint a Teller Committee for this. The Chair appoints a Teller Committee consisting of Senator Lundy as Chairman, and Senators Lamb and Rogers. Please come forward and assist in tabulating the election for the Chairman of the Administrative Rules and Regulations Committee. Senators Rogers, Lundy and Lamb. Is Senator Rogers here? Okay. The Clerk will announce the result of the vote.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Higgins has received 24 votes, Senator Hannibal has received 24 votes, there has been one abstention.

PRESIDENT: The result then is not achieved. The winning member must receive 25 votes so the Legislature will proceed to ballot again for the Chairmanship of the Administrative Rules and Regulations Committee. Please mark your ballots again voting either for Senator Hannibal or Senator Higgins. The Clerks will collect your votes and the same Teller Committee will act to tabulate the vote. The tabulating committee will please come forward, the Teller Committee, Senators Rogers, Lundy and Lamb. The tabulating committee will please tabulate the vote and report the same to the Clerk. The Clerk will report the tabulation of this vote. Yes, the Clerk will announce the vote.
