PRESIDENT: Senator DeCamp, you have been reelected Chairman of the Committee on Banking, Commerce and Insurance. We will proceed to the election on committee Chairman, the Committee on Business and Labor. Are there nominations? Senator Warner.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, I rise to nominate Senator Bill Barrett to be reelected Chairman of the Business and Labor Committee. Each of us that serve in this body have the opportunity and the privilege to developing friends for which we have a great deal of admiration and respect.
