PRESIDENT: Thank you. Are there further nominations for...Senator Wesely. Are there other nominations? The Chair recognizes Senator Wesely.

SENATOR WESELY: Thank you, Mr. President. I would move that a unanimous ballot be cast for Tim Hall for E & R Chairman.
