Now I've always been opposed to high-speed police chases, innocent third parties would get injured. I got an amendment added to the bill so that third parties, innocent third parties, could be compensated. Special deputies exist in Nebraska, at least in Douglas County to a great extent, where they are not deputy sheriffs, but they carry guns, arrest people and so forth. I, in conjunction with Senator DeCamp, got some training requirements into the law relative to those individuals, not those on the cutting edge of social issues, as we were told about did that. On the Interstate, because Nebraska is a vast agricultural state with a lot of territory and not many people, I got a provision into the law, which the World Herald doesn't like, that says if you are speeding only ten miles an hour over the limit no court costs, \$10 fine, no points off your license. It was controversial, but I believed it so I did it. The sheriffs now have to undergo continuing training in this state because of a bill I got through. I got rid of the bounty system whereby a sheriff was paid so much for each prisoner that he fed. So out in parts of the state, where they had a large native American population, they'd bring a person in a few minutes before midnight, let him go a couple of minutes afterward, and collect for two meals for two days although no single meal was paid, and sheriffs were making more money through this process than they were through their salary. The only civil rights act that exists in this state, and this is not of great interest to those in this body, but to those who need it, was the one that I got on the books. District elections for City Council in Omaha, and the School Board in Omaha, resulted, for the first time in history, in a black person being elected to the City Council serving as acting Mayor. The first time that a black person has been elected to the School Board in Omaha occurred a couple of days ago and, had it not been for the district bill, she probably would not even be on the School Board.
