implement the budget itself are not included in this motion, right? In other words, a bill can be referred to us. Say, Senator Rogers introduces a bill, it is referred to us, yes, you are saying that is not included if we advance it. But if we introduce the bill ourselves as the Appropriations Committee, is that also excluded? A substantive legislation bill, is that also excluded?

CLERK: Senator, it seems to me, and Senator Warner can address this better than I, that that would depend on whether or not that was contemplated to be part of the total legislative appropriations package. If it is part of the appropriations package, then I assume it would be outside the scope of this rule.

SENATOR GOODRICH: Well, the appropriations package, for example, it can be an appropriations bill that does nothing but appropriate money. The substantive legislation to implement that or to implement a change in the legislation that is on the books already, which in turn implements that, that is the part I want to clear up and make sure that we are not limiting ourselves as the Appropriations Committee to implement...to introduce more than one priority bill to implement what the dollar amounts were in the budget bill itself.

PRESIDENT: Senator Goodrich, you have some time left, would you care to yield some of that time to Senator Warner? Would that be helpful?

SENATOR GOODRICH: That would be fine.

PRESIDENT: Senator Warner.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President and members of the Legislature, as I understand the proposed...it would only affect, as I think has been explained, legislation that is referenced to the Appropriations Committee the same as other committees. Historically, at least as the rule is currently written, I don't see how we are affected whether it is one or two because historically those bills that directly tie to the appropriation bill has always been considered part of that package and I think that is the understanding that everybody has functioned with in the past. I see no problem with that aspect of it and obviously there is no way to know how many of those bills there might be, but seldom there is
