It is quite evident from just the short amount of discussion that we have had here that people feel very strongly about this. I would like to suggest that with the membership on the committees that you have that we would be very happy to take this proposal and give everyone, including outsiders, a chance to express their opinion on it if it is, in fact, referred to the Rules Committee. And in the interest of time, this could be the solution for this very definite proposal. Thank you.

PRESIDENT: The Chair recognizes Senator Chambers. The issue is the motion to rerefer the matter to the Rules Committee.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. Chairman and members of the Legislature, without talking about the merits of any of the proposals, if this goes to the Rules Committee, I wish they would look very carefully at the enforcement proposition. And you should know that you are going to run into a difficult time trying to punish me. I am not anybody's child other than my mother and father. I was elected by people in my district to come down here and do a job. You can punish me on beginning day, as Senator Remmers alluded to, by the way you vote and organize, but that is some of that pettiness that I think you could find with any organization. But when it comes to impairing my ability to do my job there is nobody, no collection of bodies on the floor of this Legislature who is going to punish me any kind of a way for anything that I do. I think it is the height of arrogance, it is a misdirected notion to think that some collection of people called the Rules Committee, I don't
