CLERK: 36 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of the resolution.

PRESIDENT: Legislative Resolution 14 is adopted.

CLERK: Mr. President, in conjunction with that, I have a request from Senators Lowell Johnson and Haberman to add their names as co-introducers.

PRESIDENT: Without objection, so ordered. Do you have matters for the record?

CLERK: Yes, sir. Public Health Committee will be holding an executive session underneath the north balcony right now. That is Public Health Committee underneath the north balcony immediately.

PRESIDENT: Okay, the Public Health Committee has been notified they have a meeting now underneath the north balcony and the Clerk will proceed with the introduction of bills.

CLERK: Mr. President, new bills. (Read for the first time by title the following bills: LB 223-225. See page 196 of the Legislative Journal.)

PRESIDENT: May I have your attention please. Before they may want to leave, I have the honor of introducing, on behalf of Senator Higgins, her guests this morning who are in the north balcony.
