PRESIDENT: Motion is to advance LB 2. Is there further discussion? If not, the motion is to advance the bill. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. The motion is to advance LB 2, a revisor bill. Please record your vote. The motion is to advance LB 2, a technical revisor bill. Please record your vote, 25 votes required. Please record your vote on LB 2, a revisor bill. Have you all recorded your vote? The Clerk will record.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to advance LB 2, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Motion prevails. LB 2 is advanced. LB 3.

CLERK: LB 3 introduced by Senator Beutler as Chairman of the Board. (Read title.)

PRESIDENT: Senator Beutler.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Again, Mr. President, a purely technical bill and again it is like LB 2 in that it is correcting statutory reference numbers. I would ask its advancement.
