

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Beutler.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Mr. Speaker, members of the Legislature, the Clerk read the key words. The Bicentennial Commission terminated last year and we no longer need these statutes. I'd move the advancement of the bill.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Any other discussion? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Please vote. Would the members in the front row please vote, if they care to do so. Thank you. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to advance the bill, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: LB 8 advances. Mr. Clerk, LB 9.
