CLERK: Mr. President, the first Revisor's bill this morning is LB 13. It is offered by Senator Beutler as Chairman of the Board. (Read title. See page 257 of the Legislative Journal.)

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Beutler.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Mr. Speaker, members of the Legislature, all the bills I will be discussing this morning are again Revisor of Statutes bills and are again, in my opinion, strictly technical in nature. LB 13, which is the bill we are on now, provided for the renaming of a particular cash fund and the cash fund was renamed in 1971 and the statute is simply no longer pertinent to anything. So I would move the advancement of the bill, Mr. Speaker.

SPEAKER NICHOL: You have heard the discussion, any further discussion? All those in favor of the bill vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to advance LB 13.

SPEAKER NICHOL: LB 13 advances. LB 14, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 14 offered by Senator Beutler as Chairman of the Board. (Read title. See page 257 of the Legislative Journal.)

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Beutler.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Mr. Speaker, members of the Legislature, these provisions of the law had to do with an episode we had last year, Senator Hefner would remember well, where we were trying to straighten out a license plate problem and it was straightened out, but the measures that were necessary were temporary in nature through the use of renewal tabs and the whole business was completed as of May 1, 1984, and, therefore, the statutes are obsolete. Move the advancement of the bill.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Any further discussion on LB 14? If not, you've heard the explanation of the bill. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Please vote.
