CLERK: Mr. President, first of all before we proceed to Revisor bills I have a reference report from the Reference Committee referring LBs 319-424. (See pages 275-278 of the Legislative Journal.)

Mr. President, the first Revisor bill I have this morning is LB 19 by Senator Beutler as Chairman of the Board. (Read by title for the first time. See page 278 of the Legislative Journal.) The bill is referred directly to General File.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Beutler.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Once again, Mr. Speaker, members of the Legislature, once again, but for the last time, we're going to go through a series of Revisor's statutes all of which are technical in nature. LB 19, which we are on right now, provides an operative date for certain sections of the statutes. The date provided was March 14, 1974. That has long since past. The statute is obsolete. I'd move its advancement, Mr. Speaker.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Any further discussion on LB 19? If not, you've heard the explanation. All those in favor of advancement vote aye, opposed nay.

CLERK: Senator Chizek voting yes.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to advance LB 19.

SPEAKER NICHOL: LB 19 is advanced. LB 20.

CLERK: LB 20 by Senator Beutler as Chairman of the Board. (Read title. See page 278 of the Legislative Journal.)

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Beutler.
