

with the 4-H Farm Awareness group. We welcome you to our Chamber this morning. Thank you for coming. The motion is the advancement of LB 109. The Chair recognizes...Senator Higgins, do you wish to speak on the advancement? Senator Higgins, do you wish to speak on the motion to advance LB 109 again?

SENATOR HIGGINS: Only to mention that I think the bill needs some amendments as Senator Hannibal pointed out and I think we probably ought to hold the bill until Senator Johnson can work out his amendments. That is the only problems I have with it. As far as management goes, I still read that bill as meaning my janitor as a manager and maybe he is going to need a broker's license. So I think I will have to vote against the advancement and ask for the Attorney General's opinion on the bill.

PRESIDENT: Senator Barrett, you may close. First, Senator Barrett, I would like to just say another former Senator is running around back there. We welcome him back, Senator Tommy Fitzgerald. Senator Barrett, you may close.

SENATOR BARRETT: Thank you, Mr. President. With or without Senator Higgins' approval, I would urge the body to advance the bill to E & R Initial. Senator Hannibal has been kind enough to share with me his concerns with reference to the word "management." I think Senator Hannibal raises a very legitimate concern, one which I had not considered. We will work together, Senator Hannibal and I, and perhaps bring to you on Select File an amendment which will take care of his concern and, incidentally, my concern. I move the bill be advanced.

PRESIDENT: Motion is to advance LB 109 from General File to E & R for review. All those in favor of advancing the bill vote aye, opposed vote nay. The motion is to advance LB 109. Please record your vote. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? The Clerk will record.
