SENATOR MARSH: Senator Goodrich.

SENATOR GOODRICH: Madam Chairperson and members of the body, have I got that right?

SENATOR MARSH: Very right. Thank you.

SENATOR GOODRICH: I guess I am right for a change, Shirley. The purpose of this bill is to increase the cash funds that are allowed on the various campuses of the University. We have to do this periodically. We did it in '69, I think it was, and then we did it again in 1979 and about five or six years have passed so we have to do it again. The various locations on each of the campuses have to have cash funds such as a book store, the cafeteria and various and sundry other places on the University where they need a cash fund to operate with. In essence, we are just increasing the amount for the whole University system with the exception of the UN-O campus from \$300,000 to \$475,000. From the UN-O campus it would be \$100,000 to \$175,000. And there is no revenue loss or no cash fund cost to this at all. All we are doing this for is a convenience of the various campuses of the University. I would urge your adoption of the bill.

SENATOR MARSH: Seeing no further lights, we will vote on the advancement of LB 151. Those in favor vote aye, opposed no. Senator Marsh voting aye.

CLERK: Senator Marsh voting yes.

SENATOR MARSH: The Clerk will record.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to advance the bill, Madam President. (See page 449 of the Legislative Journal.)

SENATOR MARSH: LB 151 is advanced.

CLERK: LB 417 offered by the Education Committee and signed by its members. (Read title.) The bill was read on January 18 of this year for the first time. It was referred to the Education Committee. The bill was advanced to
