PRESIDENT: Them motion is to advance LB 193. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Please record your vote on the advancement of LB 193. Have you recorded your vote? Clerk will record.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to advance the bill. (See page 455 of the Legislative Journal.)

CLERK: (Read title.) The bill was read on January 16 of this year. It was referred to the Public Works Committee for hearing. The bill was advanced to General File. I have no amendments to the bill.

PRESIDENT: Chair recognizes Senator Beyer.

SENATOR BEYER: Mr. Speaker and colleagues, this is a very simple bill. It just updates the time that the military can get their license renewed. There is a little ambiguity in the law the way it is. The county treasurers asked if I would introduce this, I think primarily because the biggest share of the military are in Senator Hartnett's and my district. So, with that, I would ask for the advancement of the bill.
