SENATOR HIGGINS: Could I have a point of clarification, Mr. Chairman?

SENATOR HIGGINS: I am terribly confused. The board says, LB 662 and 679. Now I understand Senator Vard Johnson withdrew his rerefer 662 so we're still going to go on 662 and 669? 679?

SPEAKER NICHOL: Yes.

SENATOR HIGGINS: And vote on whether or not what the agenda says, they be referred from Executive Board-Education to Education? Am I correct on that? Now they want to change it to Education and Revenue?

SPEAKER NICHOL: Yes. Yes, Senator Higgins, we're voting...(interruption)

SENATOR HIGGINS: Okay, I really am confused on it.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Well, we're voting on Senator Haberman's motion which says that both LB 662 and 679 shall be referred to the Education and the Revenue Committees and a vote "yes" would refer both of those bills to those committees and a vote "no" would leave it in the Education and Executive Board Committees.

SENATOR HIGGINS: Thank you, Mr. Chairman.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Yes, your welcome. All those in favor of the motion vote aye, opposed nay. Yes, we are under call. Eight are still excused. Have you all voted that care to? I believe everybody is present that is not excused. So
